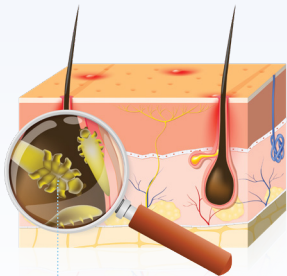


WHAT IS DEMODEX?

An infestation or overpopulation of the otherwise innocuous Demodex Brevis mites that live in or near the hair follicles of your eyes. In large numbers, these mites can physically block the sebaceous glands, including the meibomian glands in which they reside.



WHAT IS DEMODICOSIS?



Demodex

An infection caused by an infestation of Demodex Brevis. Numerous eye mites will bury themselves head-first within a hair follicle. This can result in gland obstruction and secondary complications, including chalazia, chronic conjunctival inflammation and corneal lesions.

DEMODEX can lead to:

- Blepharitis (Inflammation of the eyelids)
- Infection & swelling
- MGD
- Reduction of visual acuity
- Rosacea (redness)
- Permanent loss of eye lashes

PREVENTION

80% success rate. At lower concentrations (5%), when used regularly over 30-60 days, Tea Tree Oil is effective in preventing the reproduction of Demodex⁽¹⁾.

Tea Tree Oil is even more effective when combined with Hyaluronic Acid, which acts as a gelling agent. The rheological properties of HA allow TTO to remain in place for an extended period of time, increasing its efficacy in eradicating the mites.
